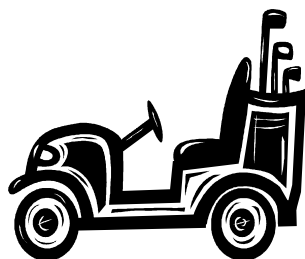

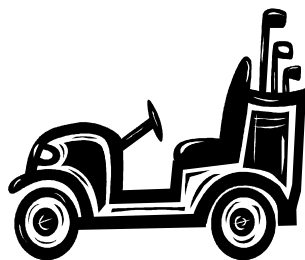

I started at the city a week after turning 18 yrs old (a teenager) in April 1980.

2013 marks my 34th season!

I have spent my life since a teenager in the golf industry!

Maple Ridge was 9 holes at that time and McCall Lake didn't exist until 1982.

The marshall program started in 1989 with just a few marshalls. Stan Skerry is the last remaining Marshall from 1989.

I took over the marshall program in 1994 and did it alone with 150 + marshalls.

Golf Courses introduced the 1st tee greeter segment of the program in 1996 and Brad Neate was hired and stayed for a few years and then Gary Taylor came along (2000-2007) then Mike Dick (2007), then Greg Leacock.

The program currently has over 350 volunteers at 6 locations (8 golf courses) many of whom are FLC Seniors Mixed Golfers.

Natalie's memories of Maple Ridge:

Maple Ridge in 1980- the course was only 9 holes. Hole #10 now was #1 back then. We had this older clubhouse with the washrooms outside (much like Shaganappi) and there was a lounge area across a breeze way with couches and coffee tables which strangely enough is our now board room where the fireplace is. We were very busy, mostly for sure a gentlemen's sport.

1988- Was back to work at Maple Ridge, things had changed, the clubhouse got a face lift, counters were changed around and painted. The walls between the breezeway were taken out and the clubhouse became quite big. Washrooms were still outside; however hole #7 now was the new #1. The construction was in the early stages of creating another 9 holes to make Maple Ridge one of the most inviting 18 hole golf courses. The clubhouse was next and was to sit exactly where the old clubhouse was. This was completed and ready to open for the Spring of 1995.

1995-2005- Busy, busy, busy- we had a great team of staff and even better group of golfers. Maple Ridge was hopping - busy with tee times, tournaments, banquets for golf, anniversary, wedding, and birthday parties. Restaurant was fully operational and the food was good. To me - those were the best golf years. We were busy with Men's and Ladies Clubs as well as everyone's favourite....our FLC Seniors. With starters like Sheila, Stacie and Nancy back then we had a great atmosphere.

☹️ Sadly- 2006 onward was the start of no longer booking tournaments which also meant no banquets. By the end of 2006 we had closed the kitchen and went back to a regular concession much like the other sites. Maple Ridge still continues to be a very busy course; after allit is the Country Club of the City of Calgary Golf Courses!!
