Tamara Van Horne is a Calgary theatre artist who wears many hats. She is an actor, director, producer, and now Artistic Director of the Calgary Fringe Festival. She has worked with organizations like Out of Our Heads Arts Foundation, Urban Stories Theatre, and Sundog Storytellers. She trained at Company of Rogues Actors' Studio. Her stage work includes both dramatic and comedic roles, with favorites like Mrs. Tilford (*The Children's Hour*), Flo Owens (*Picnic*), and Dina Dranchukin (*Recommended for Mercy*). She has also performed with the FLC Seniors Acting Club in *Lost & Found: Beth's Discovery.*

Tamara's approach to teaching focuses on instinct, presence, and honest connection centred on imagination and expression, and not polished perfection. She works to create a welcoming space where mature actors, whether returning to the stage or trying it for the first time, can take bold risks, trust their gut, and grow their skills with confidence. She believes it is never too late to develop your voice, your talent, and your joy in performing.



Auditioning for the Stage

This theatre audition class gives adult performers a clear, practical system to prepare and deliver strong auditions for theatre. You'll learn how to stage your piece so your body supports your choices, reduce nerves with focused preparation, and walk into the room with confidence. We'll cover everything from selecting material to small talk, and exit. Each participant will work on a monologue from start to finish, with peer and instructor feedback, mock theatre auditions, and measurable progress by the final class.

This class is ideal for actors returning to theatre, exploring new material, or refining their theatre audition presence.
