2013 FLC Golf Activity report for May 11, 2013 Council Meeting
(FLC Seniors Board) - Ralph Lefteruk

We held our golf registration on Saturday, April 13, 2013 in the Trico Centre Seniors Lounge and MP room #9 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm with the assistance of 30 volunteers. We have had the same volunteers dedicated to assisting us for many years with a few changes for various personal reasons.

On registration day 345 golfers signed up with 261 renewals and 84 being new. As of today, we have 390 golfers of which 97 are new. We have 99 members that golfed last year that have not yet renewed for this year. Therefore, we are budgeting for 420 members.

Being that 2013 is the 30th anniversary of the FLC Mixed Golf Activity 329 sleeves of logoed golf balls were handed out at registration to commemorate the 30th anniversary. All golfers registering throughout the season will also receive a sleeve of golf balls.

We have block bookings at 4 golf courses: Maple Ridge on Mondays: HeatherGlen on Tuesdays: Douglasdale on Wednesdays: GCCC (par three) formerly known as RCGA on Thursdays (near Burnco) and last but not least we start hitting golf balls at the National Golf Academy Golf Dome at 50th Avenue in February until the last Tuesday in April. We start golfing May 1st or earlier if weather permits. We hold 3 tournaments at each golf course plus the Stampede Tournament at Douglasdale and the Fall Classic at HeatherGlen in September. Booking times and schedules for each week are done through the website with the assistance of Lowell Frank and Dan Bell. Thanks to you both.

Our windup will be on September 7, 2013 at the Acadia Recreation Centre Rose Hall.

Lastly, we (Ralph & Linda Lefteruk) compiled a Historical Information Booklet commemorating the 30th Anniversary of the FLC Seniors Golf Club Activity which we would like to share with all our golfers. The planning of how to distribute it is still under revision at this time.

The Directors all agreed that Dan Bell purchase it before August 31, 2014.

A further discussion took place and it was decided going forward that 50/50 money (After Draws) stay with the Golf Activity to be used for prizes. Tickets are to be sold for \$1.00 each.

In October 2014 we were offered by the City of Calgary a block booking at Lakeview Golf Course beginning May 1, 2015 - August 31, 2015.

2014 FLC Golf Activity report for February 15, 2014 Council Meeting
(FLC Seniors Board) - Terry Sly

Once again, our 2013 golf season was a great success. This year was our 30th Anniversary with 405 members signed up. Out of the 405 members, we were pleased to see 108 new faces signed up this year ready to experience fun with the FLC golfers. What better way to mark this corner stone in time, but to hand out a sleeve of golf balls marked with the FLC 30th Anniversary insignia to each registered member.

The following is a quick overview of our 2013 golf season:

- Our 2013 golf season started on the first week of May.

- June proved to be a challenge as all the rain kept coming. The flood completely shut down the GCCC course for the entire season; however,

we were quickly able to acquire some Tee times at the City Lakeview golf course to keep our GCCC members golfing through the summer.

- Friday July 5th presented our Annual Stampede Tournament at the Douglasdale Golf course. Once again it was a great success with 81 golfers having fun.
- September 3rd presented our Annual Fall Classic Tournament at the HeatherGlen Golf course. We ended our regular golf season with 83 golfers.
- We smacked the last ball in Late September to mid October. So even with the challenging wet summer, we enjoyed an active season.
 - **The Golf Dome:** The indoor driving range continues to attract the eager golfers each spring starting each February, with an average of 20 to 25 golfers perfecting their swing and getting ready for the start of the golf season in May.
 - **Maple Ridge:** Each week up to 90 web requests were reviewed and sorted to fill all the 68 spots allotted each week. The rain presented some issues this year, but we were still able to get 58 to 68 golfers out each week. August 26th was our last day of golf at the City Maple Ridge golf course.

- **HeatherGlen:** Due to all the road construction this year we averaged 35 golfers each week. Golfers had a nice long season that lasted until October 15th this year.
- **Douglasdale:** The rain didn't hamper us much this year as we averaged 50 to 65 golfers each week. Golfers had their final game on September 25th.
- **Golf Canada:** As you know the flood completely shut this course down as they had a lot of damage and had to rework the entire course. We were lucky to be able to acquire tee times at the City Lakeview course so an average of 28 golfers could golf each week through the summer. September 5th, we secured the Lil Devil 9

hole course for the GC golfers to have a final golf day to end their season. They all thought that their golf season was done in August when the City courses shut down for the year, so this proved to be a great decision having 36 golfers out to play their last game for the year. The good news is the Golf Canada course will be up and operating again this May, so our GC golfers will be happy to return to their favorite course.

- Our 2013 Year end Wind-up was another huge success, with a great meal, fun for all and lots of prizes. We had 223 members join us at the ARC to socialize and have fun with all their FLC friends. By a show of hands, everyone had a fantastic night and wanted us to continue with our present yearly programs and tournaments.

We continue to have a great active group each year, with everyone coming out each week to have fun and keep active. We continue to acknowledge all the work done by our volunteers at all our tournaments as well as throughout the year.

We believe that 2014 will be another banner year for the Golf activity, with our April 12th registration day quickly approaching.

Last year's total membership count ended at 573 members (177 new members and 396 renewals). We experienced a slow registration this year (2018) on April 7th. with us only generating 439 registered members. We contributed the lower turnout to the late return of our snowbirds due to April snow, as well as the super busy Saturday parking lot at Trico. We plan on exploring the opportunity to move our registration to a Friday next year, just to see if this will help our busy registration day. Over the past month our membership team has been very busy signing up an additional 96 golfers.

So, as of yesterday, May 11th, this year's golf membership count is at 535 golfers (115 new members and 420 renewals). So, at this pace and with the sunny days now returning, we are still reasonably confident

that we will surpass last year's total of 573 members by mid golf season.

With our growing membership numbers, this year we are all focusing on sending all the membership queries to our Golf Webpage, in order to help cut down on the number of calls and questions that are directed to the home phones of our golf committee. This new web direction seems to be helping us so far.

Having said this, we are introducing a new "Golf membership Notice" to the staff at the Trico registration desk which will direct them to our webpage for sign up instead of providing them with our personal phone numbers. We continue to offer our members our same 5 golf courses as last year. However, with the continued head count rising over the past few years, we must continue to take advantage of opportunities when they arise.

Therefore, we are now excited to add a monthly golf day at McKenzie Meadows starting May 24th this month. Once again using our webpage to measure the interest of our new addition, we received an overwhelming total of over 40 sign ups wanting to experience McKenzie's golfing facilities.

Our Douglasdale Stampede tournament is booked for July 6th and our HeatherGlen Fall Classic Tournament is booked for September 4th. These two tournaments will continue to be our big success stories again this year, with a number of queries already to date.

In conclusion, the FLC Seniors Golf activity continues to be the largest FLC activity and remain very busy looking after our growing number of active seniors.

We actively engage in our monthly committee meetings at the McLeod Trail Co-op, in order to keep this large train on the tracks.
