^{*}Maple Ridge and Lakeview players are required to have a City Golf Profile before their first day of play even though they are playing in a FLC Golf block booking. Clubhouse staff will not do this at your first check in. If you do not already have a Profile, choose Signin to set one up after clicking here: City Golf Profile

Golf Sign Up Overview - Weekly Sign Up Required

Sign up buttons for a course will become active on the Golf web page two weeks before the date the block booking opens. Signup for dates of play can be made two weeks in advance.

Go to www.flcseniors.ca and under Activities select Golf which takes you to the Golf Home Page.

- Press the appropriate Golf Course Green Sign-Up button and then enter your new/current membership number for your Name Search. Each player must sign up individually.
- When your first name and last name initial come up, choose your Golf date and Cart or Walk then press submit. Please check the colored header line at the top of the page to make sure your request was sent successfully. DO NOT sign up for more than ONE course for any date.

Scheduled Tee Times

- Golf schedules will be posted beside each golf course Sign Up button on the Golf Web Page the day after cutoff time. To see the tee times and players click on the Schedule button. Cutoff times are different for each course.
- We request that you be at the golf course 20 minutes before your scheduled tee time and on the tee box when called to play. Late arrivals may lose their starting position.

Cancellation

- If you need to cancel and it is before the course cut-off, you can follow the same procedure you did to sign up but at the bottom of the page you will be able to cancel.
- If you need to cancel after course cutoff, please contact the course Coordinator as soon as possible and preferably before the course schedule is posted.
- If you realize you are unable to golf the day you are scheduled to play, call the clubhouse to cancel your tee time. If you are cancelling at a City course, in particular Lakeview, do not call until two hours before our first scheduled tee time.
- If you do not call the Coordinator prior to the day of play OR call the clubhouse (the day you are to play) to cancel
 your tee time, you will be listed as a NO SHOW and may not be scheduled to golf with the FLC group for the
 following week.

Slow Play

- Course Marshalls monitor the pace of play within block bookings so please do your best to abide by the golf course timing and rules.
- Keep the group in front of you within sight if you fall behind pick up your ball and move forward or play best ball until you catch up. Remember, course etiquette is about keeping up with those in front even if there is no one behind you. IT IS NOT ABOUT TIME. Finishing the front nine in two hours when you are two or even one hole behind the group in front is considered poor sportsmanship.
