League/block booking members are advised to log into their golf account and verify their contact information before April 1. Click this link to take you to: <u>City Golf Profile</u> Click on **Sign In** to access profiles.

There was a City of Calgary Golf database clean up and this is a significantly important first step for all FLC Maple Ridge golfers.

Every league/block booking player needs their own account.

New Account: Create a new account if an account cannot be found using the original email.

Forgot Password: Use the password reset feature.

Each account requires a unique email address (one email = one account). Husband/wife/partners cannot use the same email address.

Account creation or updates now require name, address, postal code, unique email address, and phone number.

Flight Sheet Enforcement

Golfers with mismatched account details (obtained from the FLC Seniors Club membership database) on the tee sheet, or their account cannot be confirmed, will be removed from the tee sheet, and their spot will be opened to public players.

Pre-Purchase Readiness

Ensure accounts are fully set up before calling to purchase Mi7 or Easy Golf during preseason sales next week.

League Player confirmation List to be submitted by FLC Golf Activity

City Profiles, current FLC Seniors Club memberships and FLC Golf memberships must be in place when the Maple Ridge and Lakeview FLC membership lists are prepared April 5

Golfers not included on this list will not be added to a Maple Ridge or Lakeview tee sheet during the 2025 season.

Playing in Only One City League

The City of Calgary refers to each of its weekly golf block bookings with various organizations as a "league". Therefore, the FLC Seniors Club block booking at MAPLE RIDGE on Mondays and LAKEVIEW on Thursdays are considered to be "leagues".

The City has implemented a new rule for the 2025 golf season that any individual player may only play in one " league" during the whole season. What this means is members of the FLC Seniors Club Golf Activity who played at Maple Ridge or Lakeview in the past as

well as with any other organization such as the Maple Ridge Ladies on Tuesdays or the McCall Lake Men on Thursdays as an example, will have to pick one "league" to play in.

The FLC Seniors Club Golf Activity will advise our members of this new rule but will NOT be monitoring where else our members play other than with FLC as that is not our responsibility nor is it any of our business.

However, should the City advise us that one of our members is not abiding by this rule and are playing in more than one "league", we will have to address this issue with the individual and a suspension from playing at Maple Ridge may occur.

The FLC Seniors Club Golf Activity has five other non-City block bookings each week that do not fall under these new rules.
